TCTA Bursary Scheme

Preference for financial aid will be given to the following fields of study:

- Engineering Studies: Civil, Mechanical, Chemical and Electrical (Controls & Instrumentation)
- Environmental Studies: Environmental Policy & Management, Conservation Biology
- Accounting: Auditing & Finance Studies

The bursary provides funding up to R200,000.00 per bursar annually for the following expenses:

- Full university tuition fees, including registration
- Accommodation costs
- Meal allowance
- Study tools (e.g., laptop and prescribed books)
- Monthly allowance

Upon completing their studies, bursary recipients are offered an opportunity to participate in a two-year training programme with TCTA, gaining valuable experience and skills to help them launch their careers in their chosen fields.”
