SCOPE OF WORK

DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF GOODS/SERVICES

- 1.1 Appointment of a service provider for the provision of office kitchen consumables for a period of 24 months.
- 1.2 The service provider will be responsible for the supply and delivery of office kitchen consumables as and when required and agreed with TCTA.
- 1.3 TCTA will place orders for the required goods as and when required. The order frequency is usually once per week but this may vary in line with the business need.
- 1.4 No fewer than one order will be placed per month and it is unlikely that more than 5 orders will be placed during any given calendar month.
- 1.5 The service providers shall source and deliver the ordered items in line with the order placement and delivery schedule presented in Table 1 below.
